Manual, start in the second week of March. Special export lot.

VINEYARDS

High density trellises. Age: 20 years

WINE TASTING

Intense in color with violet reflections, on the nose red fruit scent and flowers typical of the variety stand out with a slight spicy touch. On the palate it is broad, with balanced acidity and a persistent finish.
